Sir,

I am directed to say that it is proposed to fill up of one post of Joint Commissioner (Fisheries-Anti Poaching Law) in the Ministry of Agriculture, Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries in the General Central Service, Group 'A' Gazetted in the pay scale of Rs.37400-67000 + 8700 (GP) (revised) Rs.14300-400-18300/- (pre-revised) on transfer on deputation (including short term contract basis) from amongst:

Officers of the Central/State Governments/Agricultural Universities/Recognized Research Institutions or Councils/Semi-Government, Statutory or Autonomous Organizations:-

- a) (i) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or Department ; or
(ii) With three years' regular service in post in the scale of pay of Rs.15600-39100 + 7600 (GP) (revised) Rs.12000-375-16500/- (pre-revised) or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and

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b) Possessing experience in the field of fisheries development both marine and inland.

[Period of deputation (including short-term contract) including period of deputation (including short-term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed 3 (three) years.]

2. The duties and responsibilities attached with the post of Joint Commissioner (Fisheries-Anti Poaching Law) is given below:

- i) Scrutiny of State Plan, Annual Plan discussions
- ii) Coordination of the results of research at Fisheries Research Institutions and field work of State Fisheries Department
- iii) Assistance in policy formulation, dealing with foreign exports and fellowship relating to fisheries
- iv) International Fisheries matters etc.
- v) Issue of technical/administrative approval to states (a) Pattern of assistance/regularisation of expenditure in excess of financial and administrative limits of States
- vi) Preparation of briefs for Central teams and follow up action.
- vii) Preparation of special project report on (a) Pilot Schemes for development of Fisheries in Sundarbans (b) Development of Fisheries in hilly areas.

3. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short-term contract) shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

4. It is requested that applications (in duplicate) of willing and eligible officers in the enclosed proforma, along with the following documents may please be forwarded to this department within 60 days from the date of issue of this letter or from the date of advertisement of vacancy in the Employment News, whichever is later:

- i) Copies of last five years Confidential Reports Dossier, each page duly attested by an officer not below the rank of Under Secretary,
- ii) Duly attested cadre clearance certificate,
- iii) Duly attested minor/major penalties certificate of last ten years,
- iv) Duly attested vigilance clearance certificate,
